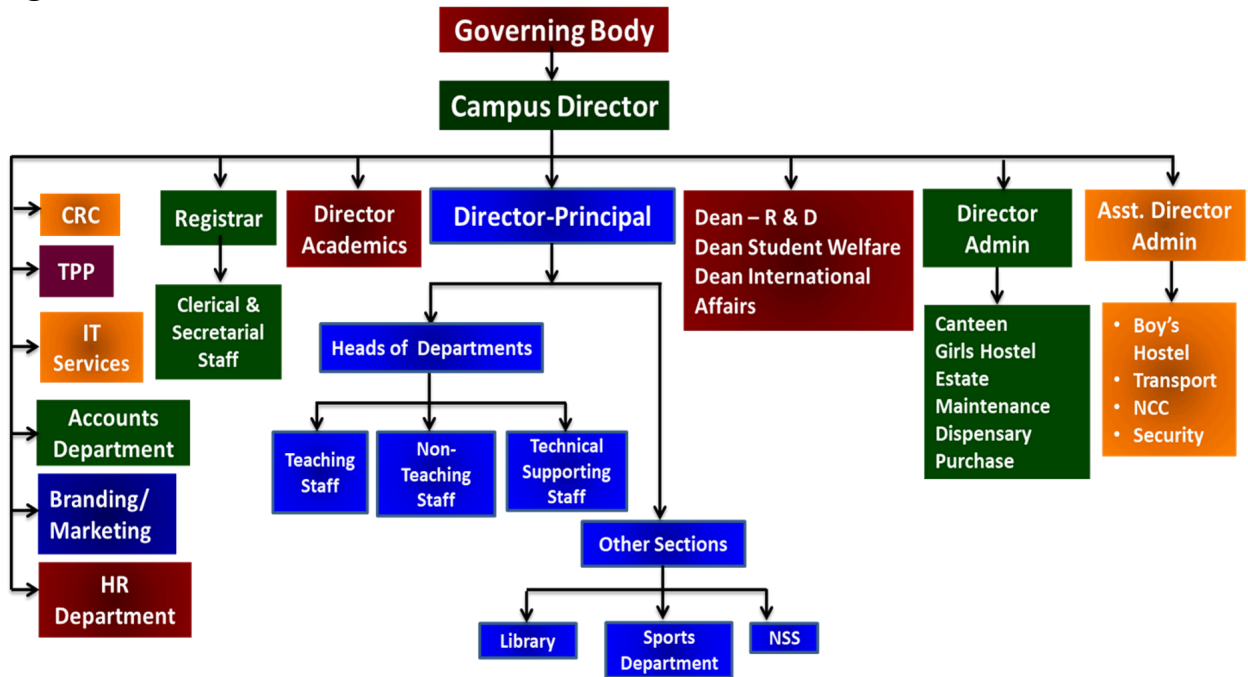


AFFILIATION / CONTINUATION ORDER

In exercise of the powers conferred upon by the Vice-Chancellor under Section 10(5) of the I. K. Gujral Punjab Technical University, Chandigarh College of Technology, Landran, Mohali, situated at Landran, Mohali, Punjab (126) is granted affiliation with I. K. Gujral Punjab Technical University on provisional basis, for a period of one year, for running the following courses with an intake as specified, for the Academic Session 2025-26, subject to the following terms and conditions: -


1. The College shall have to create and maintain the necessary infrastructure as per the norms of AICTE/PCI/COA/PSCAE/UGC/University and amended from time to time.
2. The institution shall constitute a Planning and Monitoring committee for the continuous monitoring and implementation of norms and standards of the University. There shall be an evaluation of the Institution by the University periodically as and when desired by the University.
3. The Governing Body of the Institution shall be constituted, and its Chairman/President shall be appointed as per the guidelines of the University/Bylaws of society/trust/competent authority.
4. Adequate funds shall be available with the Institution to meet the financial obligations of recurring and non-recurring nature for smooth conduct of courses, as per the norms of AICTE/PCI/COA/PSCAE/UGC/University.
5. Principal and Faculty shall be appointed by the institute according to the procedure (vide letter No. IKGPTU/Reg./1150 Dated 13.06.2016), qualifications, experience and applicable pay scales shall be as per the norms of AICTE/PCI/COA/PSCAE/UGC/University. The salary should be disbursed through bank on monthly basis.
6. The institute shall have to maintain faculty student ratio (FSR) and other facilities like laboratories, computers centre, library etc., as per the norms of AICTE/PCI/COA/PSCAE/UGC/University.
7. The Institution will have an independent building and facilities with a separate approach and shall have a separate Principal/Director/faculty and other facilities as per the applicable norms of AICTE/PCI/COA/PSCAE/UGC/University.
8. The institute is not authorized to start new course/increase or decrease in sanctioned intake/ closure of course/college/discontinuation without prior approval of the University.
9. Colleges offering Agriculture Course are required to comply with norms of Punjab State Council of Agricultural Education/University.


10. The institute shall maintain the website of institute and display the details of courses offered department wise along with all requisite facilities and faculty.
11. Admissions shall be made according to regulations /directions and eligibility criteria notified by the Punjab Govt/AICTE/PCI/COA/PSCAE/UGC/University.
12. The tuition and other fees shall be charged from students as prescribed by the State Govt./University. The Institute shall be responsible for levy, payment and collection of taxes as may be applicable to Institute. The University shall at all times, have the right to recover from Institute all the dues on account of tuition and other fees as prescribed by the State Govt./University. Further, the Institute shall at all times be liable to make payment of such taxes (including but not limited to goods and service tax, as applicable from time to time) as may be levied and demanded by the University. There might be a situation that University adopts a particular tax position, however, in case such tax position is changed for any reason whatsoever as per the sole discretion of University, the Institute shall as and when demanded by University, be liable to indemnify the University to for an amount equivalent to tax implications of such changed tax position along with applicable interest and penalty (if any) to the University within the specified period. It is clarified herein that such indemnified amount may be demanded by University for the period prior to the present affiliation order(s) and for the period of this affiliation order at any time in future, without any prior consent of the Institute.
13. The Institution shall not charge any Capitation Fee or donation for admission or other higher charges from the students/guardians of the students in any form.
14. The Institutions shall not automatically become eligible to receive financial grant/assistance from the Central/State Govt. or any other funding agency.
15. The institution shall have to maintain the records and account books in the proper form, as per applicable norms and the same must be audited by Chartered Accountant which may be inspected any time by the University.
16. Special academic audit and surprise inspection of the institute can be conducted as and when desired by the University.
17. The institution can be visited at any time by an Officer or a committee appointed by the University to check the requisite facilities/conditions as laid down by the UGC/AICTE/PCI/COA/PSCAE/University.
18. The institute cannot run any other course affiliated with any other university in the same building allocated to the courses affiliated with IKGPTU.
19. The University can disaffiliate the institute, if it fails to deposit the continuation of affiliation fee as per schedule & non submission of continuation application form annually and non-fulfillment of requisite facilities as per the applicable norms and non-compliance of directions issued by the University from time to time.
20. The institute shall have to reconcile the accounts with Finance & Accounts of IKGPTU and deposit the pending dues/Tax Liabilities (if any) as per the directions of University.
21. University has right to close the college/course or reduce the number of sanctioned seats at any time based on the inspection-report carried by the University without any notice.
22. This approval is accorded subject to satisfactory compliance (submitted by the institute) of deficiencies (if any) pointed out by the inspection team etc. The institute may be inspected any time to verify the compliance submitted in respect of deficiencies pointed out by the expert team.
23. If institute or any members of society/trust is found to be involved in any malpractice, fraud with the governmental funds, criminal activity and proved guilty by the Hon'ble Court and punished thereafter, the affiliation can be cancelled by the University.
24. The University reserves the right to prescribe such additional, substituted/revised norms, from time to time, effective prospectively or retrospectively, as may be deemed relevant and necessary in the sole discretion of the University, without assigning any reason thereof.
25. All the institutes offering paramedical courses will have to establish all the requisite amenities/facilities/faculty/laboratories/equipments as per the rules and regulation of the concerned state/central statutory authority /State Govt./concerned Council etc
26. The institute will get approval wherever required from the concerned state/central statutory authority/ State Govt./concerned Council to run the paramedical course(s).

27. The institute will abide by the rules and regulation of the IKGPTU and concerned state/central statutory authority/ State Govt./concerned Council to run the paramedical course(s) from time to time
28. The institutes shall have to inform well in advance to all the candidates seeking admission in such courses, about the conditions under which affiliation has been awarded by the university to the college and college will be responsible to take relevant undertaking from the admission seekers in paramedical courses before seat allotment to the students.
29. The University reserves the right to cancel / withdraw the approval/affiliation of paramedical course(s) at any stage subject to any directions received from the concerned state/central statutory authority /State Govt./concerned Council etc., especially in view of letter No. Z/103/2024-AHS-DOHFW Department Govt. of India.

NOTIFICATION

1.0 The Governor of Punjab is pleased to appoint the I. K. Gujral Punjab Technical University, Kapurthala as the authority competent to make admission to Under Graduate Courses in Management (BBA) for the Academic Session 2025-26. The admission shall be made in the colleges affiliated to Universities and Campuses of the Universities mentioned below:-

1. I. K. Gujral Punjab Technical University, Kapurthala
2. Maharaja Ranjit Singh Punjab Technical University, Bathinda

Note: The name of colleges and the number of seats will be as given in the letter of approval issued by AICTE/Concerned University (in case of University Campuses / Constituent Campuses only) for the year 2025-26.

As per All Indian Council for Technical Education, New Delhi letter No. AICTE/Adv-1/AB/2016/86 dated 08.12.2016 and letter dated 07-07-2020:-

- In no eventually, a Technical Institution without prior approval of the AICTE, and affiliating University shall be allowed to participate in the counselling and admission process and to admit students. Affiliating University shall not enroll students admitted in such Technical Institutions, which do not have requisite approval of the AICTE.
- University shall not grant affiliation to a Technical Institution approved by AICTE after the last date as issued by AICTE in the Calendar Year in which the Academic Session is to commence.
- Affiliating University shall not permit any Technical Institution to admit students without requisite prior approval of the AICTE.
- University/Institution shall not permit admissions of students to Technical Program which are not approved by the AICTE.

Note: The eligibility criteria issued/revised by the respective Regulatory Body after issuance of this notification shall be followed.

2.0 The Governor of Punjab is also pleased to further issue the following criteria for making the admissions thereafter:-

A. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA (EDUCATIONAL & RESIDENT STATUS) FOR ADMISSION TO UNDER GRADUATE COURSES IN MANAGEMENT (BBA):

- (i) All those candidates who have passed 10+2 examination from board recognized or established by Central/State Government through a legislation and a member of Council of Boards of School Education (COBSE), New Delhi shall be eligible to apply for admission to Under Graduate Courses in Management (BBA)
- (ii) Candidates shall be admitted to BBA course on the basis of inter-se-merit in the qualifying examination mentioned above.
- (iii) For admission to the BBA Course, 85% seats shall be open for the candidates from within the state and 15% shall be open for the candidates from outside the state.
- (iv) 85% seats would be reserved for the candidates from within the state of Punjab and 15% will be open to all candidates from outside the state. The eligibility criteria for 85% seats will be that the candidates should be resident of Punjab state in terms of Punjab govt. Department of Personnel and Administrative Reforms (PP II Branch) letter no. 1/3/95-3PP II/9619 dated 6th June 1996 and letter no. 1/3/95-3PP II / 81 dated 1st Jan 1999,(attached as Annexure-1), or have passed qualifying examination as a regular candidate from recognized institutions situated in Punjab. However, children of Defence Personnel posted in Punjab are exempted

from this condition to the extent that they should have passed only qualifying examination i.e. 10+2 from a recognized institution situated in Punjab. Each candidate would be required to submit a certificate to this effect from the principal/head of institution last attended in the prescribed performa.

B. GENERAL ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR ADMISSION TO FOR ADMISSION TO UNDER GRADUATE COURSES IN MANAGEMENT (BBA):

Apart from the basic educational qualifications prescribed above, the general eligibility criteria shall be as contained in Punjab Government, Department of Technical Education & Industrial Training, Punjab Memo No. 35/44/95-1T(2)/978 dated 21st March, 2003, which is attached as an annexure. This communication shall be treated as a part and parcel of this notification, for all purposes, and all the provisions of this notification shall be read along with the contents of the said communication.

Exemption under above Para

Children/wards/dependent (whose parent are not alive) of all those regular Punjab Government employees, members of All India Service borne on Punjab cadre, Serving judges and the employees of the Punjab and Haryana High Court, employees of Boards/Corporations/ Statutory Bodies established by an act of the state of Punjab who have been holding post outside Punjab on or before 1st January of the year of admission that is on or before 1st January, 2024 and their children/wards /dependents have done 10+1 and/or 10+2 outside Punjab.

C. RESERVATION:

- (i) The reservation of seats shall be as per Punjab Government, Department of Technical Education and Industrial Training Memo. No. 13/2/05 – 1TE2/1987 dated 2nd July, 2013 and Memo. No. 8/41/2019 – 4 TE2/53 dated 13/09/2019, which are attached as Annexure. This communication shall be treated as a part and parcel of this notification, for all purposes, and all the provisions of this notification shall be read along with the contents of the said communication.
- (ii) The attention of the applicants desirous of claiming reservation under any category whatsoever is especially drawn to the condition and stipulation that only the certificates that have been produced at the time of admission shall be considered. The candidates are accordingly advised, in their own interest, to get the requisite certificates issued well before the date of admission, otherwise, claim for reservation shall be summarily rejected. Candidates are required to claim reservation at the time of registering for Online Centralized Counselling. If no reservation is claimed the candidates shall be treated and considered as a "General Category Candidate."
- (iii) The I.K. Gujral Punjab Technical University shall make a provision in the application form for a candidate to indicate the category, if any, under which he/she is seeking reservation. There shall also be a provision to indicate the sub-category of the category, if any, under which reservation is being sought, so that *inter se* gradation can be facilitated. These sub-categories have been elucidated in the Punjab Government, Department of Technical Education and Industrial Training memo. no. 13/2/05 – 1TE2/1987 dated 2nd July, 2013 and Memo. No. 8/41/2019 – 4 TE2/53 dated 13/09/2019 which are attached as Annexures. Punjab Government may also set up a committee to effect *inter se* gradation of candidates claiming reservation under certain categories as indicated in the aforesaid memo dated 2nd July, 2013 and memo dated 13.09.2019.
- (iv) A candidate shall be eligible to make claim for reservation in one reserved category only. However, the procedure for counselling shall be as per Punjab Government, Welfare Department (Reservation Cell) Memo. No. 7/21/2004 – RS1 / 1674 – 1677 dated 20th Dec., 2004, which is attached as Annexure.

D. GENERAL CONDITIONS

- (i) There shall be Centralized Counselling by I.K. Gujral Punjab Technical University, Kapurthala.
- (ii) There shall be two rounds of Centralized Counselling by I.K. Gujral Punjab Technical University, Kapurthala. The procedure of Centralized Counselling will be decided by the I.K.

Gujral Punjab Technical University, Kapurthala. Thereafter the direct admissions at the college level shall be allowed for vacant seats. The L.K. Gujral Punjab Technical University, Kapurthala will issue necessary instructions to the Institutions/ University in this regard.

- (iii) The students shall be liable to pay Fee / Development Fee and other charges as per the rates of Fee / Development Fee and other charges as fixed by the Government of Punjab/ AICTE/ Concerned University, from time to time.
- (iv) The management quota shall be as per Punjab Govt. Department of Technical Education and Industrial Training Memo no. 13/129/2003-1TE2/1247 dated 25th April 2008 and Notification no. 13/129/2003-1TE2/1892 dated 20th June 2008 and partial Notification no. 13/129/2003-1TE2/171 dated 18th January, 2011 which are attached as Annexures.
- (v) The last date, upto which students can be admitted against vacancies arising due to any reason will be same as notified by the AICTE in its Academic Calendar or notified by the respective regulatory body from time to time. No student should be admitted in any institution after the last date under any quota. Hence admission to these courses shall be allowed only once in an academic session.
- (vi) If any new Institution is approved or seats are increased/alterd in the existing institutions by the AICTE and such approval is received before the commencement of that particular round of counselling, L.K. Gujral Punjab Technical University will publish on the official website and invite additional Choice preference from the registered candidates. These new institutes as well as existing Institutes having addition / alternation in seats shall be taken into consideration before the start of choice filling of that particular round.
- (vii) Admissions to the BBAcourse, both for 85% seats for resident of Punjab and 15% seats for outsiders, shall be made strictly on the basis of merit of marks obtained in qualifying examination.
- (viii) Counselling for 85% seats for Punjab residents and 15% outside Punjab candidates shall be taken up simultaneously. However, the reserved category candidates shall be considered in general category first before being considered in respective reserved category.
- (ix) The College / University will make a public notice on official website to this effect indicating clearly the number of seats vacant in each reserve category and general category and fill the seats in that very particular category in both rounds of counselling.
- (x) After following the above said procedure, if still the seats remain vacant in reserve category, the college/university can fill these from candidates belonging to general category in a subsequent step at the end of Centralized Counselling. Admission to such unfilled/vacant seats as well as management quota shall be furnished to the I. K. Gujral Punjab Technical University, Kapurthala and details thereof shall be finalized within 15 days of the last of counselling.
- (xi) The guidelines for admission of Foreign Nationals / Overseas Citizen of India / Children of Indian Workers in Gulf Countries shall be as per AICTE guidelines from time to time. However, any Foreign National who had obtained School Leaving Certificate / Diploma / Degree in Foreign Institution shall produce an Equivalency Certificate issued by the Association of Indian Universities for admission to an Institution / University in India.
- (xii) The fee structure for Foreign Nationals/Persons of Indians Origin shall be the same as was in vogue for NRI candidates.
- (xiii) The guidelines for admission of Kashmiri migrants shall be as per Notification of Punjab Government in this regard.
- (xiv) Non-refundable counselling fee of Rs. 2,000/- (Rupees Two Thousand only) will be collected by the University as counselling fee from each student one time only.
- (xv) In case a student changes his / her college / University allotted during Centralized Counselling conducted by I.K. Gujral Punjab Technical University, his / her fee shall be refunded by the previous Institution after deduction of Rs. 1,000/- only and the original documents will be returned immediately.

- (xvi) In case a student surrenders his / her seat within 7 days of the end of the Centralized Counseling, he / she must submit application to the college and register on I. K. Gujral Punjab Technical University website www.ptu.ac.in. I. K. Gujral Punjab Technical University, Kapurthala shall only forward such cases to the concerned colleges / Universities and colleges must refund his / her full fee after deduction of Rs. 1000/- only.
- (xvii) In keeping with the direction of Ministry of Human Recourse Development Department, Govt. of India all Institutions and Universities shall in public interest, maintain a waiting list of students/candidates. In the event of a student/candidate withdrawing before the start of the course, the waiting list candidates should be given admissions against the vacant seat. The entire fees collected from the student, after a deduction of the processing fee of not more than Rs.1,000/- (Rupees One Thousand Only) shall be refunded by the institution/University to the student/candidate withdrawing from the programme. It would not be permissible for institutions and universities to retain the certificates in original. If a student leave after joining the course and if the seat subsequently falling vacant gets filled by another candidate by the last date of admission, the institution must return the fees collected with proportionate deduction of monthly fee and proportionate hostel rent, where applicable and the original documents will be returned immediately.
- (xviii) "Tuition Fee Waiver" Scheme (if any) will be applicable as per guidelines of AICTE.
- (xix) As per section 7 of the Aadhaar Act, 2016, use of Aadhaar Authentication Services while identifying beneficiaries and processing the benefit under any scholarship scheme of government is mandatory. The University shall adhere to the guidelines and regulations defined by Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAI)

E. OVER-RIDING PROVISION:

Nothing in this notification shall be operative in so far as it is inconsistent with the law of the land as laid down in the judgment of the honorable Supreme Court of India in the case of TMA Pai Foundation and others vs. State of Karnataka and others (2002) BSCC 481:AIR 2003 SC 355). Any such inconsistency may be brought to the notice of the Government of Punjab, clearly highlighting the inconsistency, for immediate rectification.
